LEZZER LUMBER FOOTBALL CLASSIC GAME RULES

- I. OFFENSE:** Must play with a balanced line. There must be three men on either side of center on the line of scrimmage. The offense may align in or motion to trips formation as long as one running back remains aligned in the backfield between the tackles. Each team must attempt passes on 30 % of their offensive plays. Percentages will be checked midway through the third quarter. If a team is under the 30 % pass attempt, each non-pass play will be penalized for unsportsmanlike conduct until the percentages are met and maintained. Force scrambles and sacks will be counted as pass attempts.

II. DEFENSIVE GUIDELINES

A. Four-Four-Man-Free

1. **Front:**
 - a. Tackles –inside / on / outside shoulder of guards.
 - b. Ends to the TE – inside / on / outside shoulder of the TE. Away from TE - outside shoulder of tackle (no ghost position).
 - c. All in 3 or 4-point stance.
 - d. Tackles and ends may slant, but no twists!
 - e. Tackles and ends must rush the passer.
2. **Inside Linebackers:**
 - a. Stacked on guards.
 - b. Depth of 5 yards from the LOS.
 - c. Depth may change in short yardage (2 yards or less) or goal line (10-yard line and in) situations, where the LB's may play as tight as possible and may assume a 3 or 4-point stance.
 - d. LB's react, but are never allowed to stunt – no stunts!
 - e. In passing situations, ILB's must be in coverage.
3. **Outside Linebackers:**
 - a. Align at 3 by 3 yds. to TE or tackle.
 - b. Same short yardage and goal line rules as ILB's.
 - c. OLB's react but are never allowed to stunt.
 - d. In passing situations, OLB's must be in coverage. If man motions, OLB may follow, switch, or invert with FS.
 - e. In a Trips Away formation, OLB must move over to the Trips.
4. **Corners:**
 - a. Must play man-to-man at a maximum depth of 7 yards at the snap of the ball.
 - b. If man motions, C may follow, switch, or invert with FS.
5. **Free Safety:**
 - a. Must align inside the tackle box at a maximum depth of 10 yards.
 - b. With motion, FS may invert with OLB or C.

III. DEFENSE vs. FIELD GOAL, EXTRA POINT, and PUNT

- A. Same alignment as goal line and you can rush up to as many as eight (8) players on field goal and extra point, but all eight (8) players must be on the line of scrimmage. All players must rush through the shoulder of the player they line up on. Cannot rush over the center.
- B. You may rush only two (2) players on a punt return and they are the ends. The outside linebackers can move out to play the two (2) slot men, man-to-man and no deeper than five (5) yards. The alignment of the ends, tackles, and middle linebacker are the same.
- C. On Punts, only the two (2) outside players (ends or flankers) and the center can release and go downfield before the ball is kicked (violation - 5 yards). May use trick play from a punt formation.
Short Yardage /Anytime the offense has less than three yards to go for a first down or touchdown, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end).

Point Differential If Team A scores and is behind by 9 + points, Team A will be given the Option to Kick or Receive. If Team A receives and scores on that possession and still trails by 9 + points, No option - Team A will Kickoff to Team B. Rule does not change designated second half Kickoff.

Kickoff Kickoff will be from the 35 yard line.
IF BALL IS KICKED INTO THE END ZONE, THEN THE DEFENSE IS REWARDED WITH PLACING THE BALL ON THE 15 YARD LINE.

PAT & FG PAT: BALL WILL PLACED AT 13 YD. LINE FOR A 30-YD ATTEMPT. WORTH 2 PTS. IF GOOD.
IF KICKED AT THE REGULAR SPOT, STILL WORTH 1 PT.
FG: FG OF 40+ YARDS = 4 PTS.

Kicking Game In Kicking Game situations, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end), however, no more than seven may rush on any kicking play.

Quarters / Time Each Quarter will be 12 minutes
Playing Time Each player must participate for a least 15 plays.
Tie Breaker If the score is tied at the end of regulation play it will stand as a tie.

PLAYER AND COACHES SELECTION

Players and coaches are selected for the game by members of the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association. They require that a representative attend a minimum of three CPFCA meetings before a player is eligible. Players from schools failing to meet the minimum participation requirements are not eligible for the following year.

Player Selection:

1. Graduating Senior players are nominated in writing by their head coach in December.
 - a. Each school may have no more than five players participate.
2. Players nominated are polled to ascertain that they will participate if selected.
3. Coaches from schools in each division review the nominated players and the forty players are selected by a consensus of the selection committees. (A player from each eligible school will be selected to participate in the game.)
4. This year coaches from both staffs selected alternates in case players were unable to participate for various reasons.

Coach Selection:

1. Members of the association select the coaching staff from member schools in each division – North and South.
2. The coaching staffs for each division consist of a Head Coach and five/six Associate Coaches.

MARK BANEY - STATE COLLEGE AREA -OFF LINE, ASST. HEAD COACH

A GRADUATE OF BELLWOOD-ANTIS HIGH SCHOOL WHERE HE LETTERED IN FOOTBALL, WRESTLING, AND TRACK, COACH BANEY IS ENTERING HIS 30TH YEAR OF COACHING FOOTBALL AT STATE COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL. MARK BEGAN HIS COACHING CAREER AT STATE HIGH AS A VOLUNTEER COACH DURING HIS FIRST YEAR OF STUDENT TEACHING. FOLLOWING HIS GRADUATION FROM PENN STATE HE JOINED THE SCASD FACULTY AS A PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHER WHERE HE CONTINUES TO TEACH TODAY. DURING THE OFF SEASON, MARK KEEPS HIMSELF BUSY BY GAME MANAGING VARIOUS WINTER AND SPRING SPORTS AT STATE HIGH. MARK HAS COACHED IN THE LEZZER LUMBER ALL-STAR GAME NUMEROUS TIMES AND HAS BEEN A STAPLE IN THE STATE COLLEGE FOOTBALL PROGRAM. MARK AND HIS WIFE BRENDA RESIDE IN STATE COLLEGE AND HAVE TWO CHILDREN, MATTHEW AND ALLISON.



DAVE DOMICO -- CLEARFIELD, ASST. COACH

DAVE DOMICO PLAYED FOR HIS FATHER, LYLE DOMICO, AT CURWENSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL EARNING 4 VARSITY LETTERS IN FOOTBALL AND WRESTLING. HE PLAYED UNDER COACH FRANK CIGNETTI AT INDIANA UNIVERSITY OF PA. HE JOINED TIM JANOCKO'S STAFF AT CLEARFIELD HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE 1995 SEASON. FROM 1995-2003 DOMICO COACHED THE LINEBACKERS AND RUNNING BACKS FOR THE BISON. IN THE 2004 SEASON HE TOOK OVER AS HEAD JUNIOR HIGH COACH FOR CLEARFIELD AND RAN THE PROGRAM UNTIL 2006. HE REJOINED THE VARSITY STAFF IN 2007 AS THE OFFENSIVE LINE COACH / OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR AND STILL HOLDS THAT ROLE WITH THE BISON. DURING HIS 26-YEAR TENURE AS AN ASSISTANT, THE BISON ATTAINED HAVE RECORDED 222 WINS, WITH DOMICO SERVING AS OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR FOR MOST OF THEM. CLEARFIELD HAS OVER 600 WINS AS A PROGRAM AND THE 600TH WIN ALSO OCCURRED WITH DOMICO AS COORDINATOR. DOMICO HAS TAUGHT CHEMISTRY AT CLEARFIELD HIGH SCHOOL SINCE 1993 AND RESIDES IN CLEARFIELD WITH HIS WIFE, JODI. THEY HAVE THREE CHILDREN, MADILYN, NICOLAS, AND WILL.
